

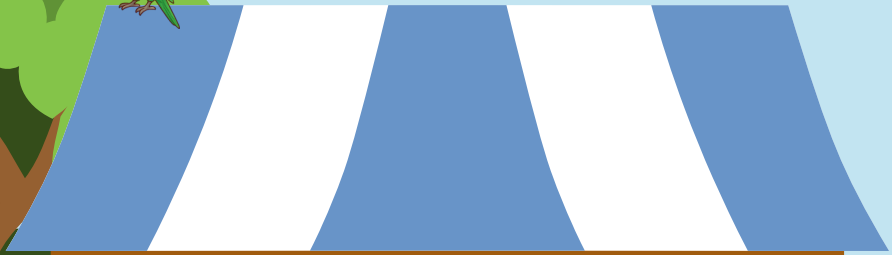

The Maternal and Child Health Service is designed to give parents support, advice and information about child and family health issues, and to monitor growth, health, development and behaviour in children. There is no cost for these services and they are available to anyone with a child 0-6 years. They can provide information, support, advice and referrals regarding:

- child health and development
- breastfeeding
- nutrition
- play and learning
- maternal/paternal health and wellbeing
- accident and injury prevention (including safe sleeping)
- home safety
- immunisation
- local support services and resources
- sleep and settling program
- family violence support

Integrated Family Services

The Mansfield Integrated Family Services provide a range of supports for parents-to-be and parents with children from birth to 18 years of age. This service is free and confidential.

Available support includes:

- Supporting your family in times of difficulty.
- Building stronger family relations and parent skills.
- Addressing children's behavioural concerns.
- Strengthening relationships between parents and children.
- Working with children to ensure their emotional and developmental needs are met.
- Advocacy on a family's behalf where required.
- Referral to other community services as required, including family violence, drug and alcohol, financial and mental health services.

GADHABA

'Gadhaba', pronounced Gud-a-bah, is a Taungurung word meaning 'Together'.
